YA ARM	<u>The Summoning</u> By Kelley Armstrong	6	Fifteen year old Chloe begins seeing ghosts and is shipped off to a group home with a diagnosis of schizophrenia. But some the others in the group home seem to have mysterious powers too.
YA BRE	<u>The Chronicles of Vladimir Tod: Eighth Grade Bites</u> By Heather Brewer	6	For thirteen years, Vlad, aided by his aunt and best friend, has kept secret that he is half-vampire. But when his missing teacher is replaced by a sinister substitute, he learns that there is more to being a vampire, and to his parents' deaths, than he could have guessed. Sequel: <i>Ninth Grade Slays</i>
YA DUE	<u>Skin Hunger</u> By Kathleen Duey	7	In alternate chapters, Sadima travels from her farm home to the city and becomes assistant to a heartless man who is trying to restore knowledge of magic to the world, and a group of boys fights to survive in the academy that has resulted from his efforts.
YA PB C *	<u>The Warrior Heir</u> By Cinda Williams Chima	6	Sixteen-year-old Jack Swift thinks he has a heart condition until one day he forgets to take his medicine and his world is turned upside down. Soon Jack finds out that he is not really sick at all, but special – one of the last remaining Warriors in an ancient underground society known as the Weirind. Sequel: <i>The Wizard Heir</i>
YA PB D *	<u>Ingo</u> By Helen Dunmore	5	After their father mysteriously disappears, Sapphy and her brother, Conor, visit Ingo, undersea kingdom of the Mer people, and find themselves yearning to return to the ocean world. Sequel: <i>The Tide Knot</i>
YA GOO	<u>Eon: Dragoneye Reborn</u> By Alison Goodman	6	Eon has been studying the ancient art of Dragon Magic for four years, hoping he'll be able to apprentice to one of the twelve energy dragons of good fortune. But he also has a dark secret. He is actually Eona, a sixteen-year-old girl who has been living a dangerous lie for the chance to become a Dragoneye, the human link to an energy dragon's power.
YA PB L *	<u>Gifts</u> By Ursula K. LeGuin	7	When a young man in the Uplands blinds himself rather than use his gift of "unmaking"--a violent talent shared by members of his family--he upsets the precarious balance of power among rival, feuding families, each of which has a strange and deadly talent of its own. Sequel: <i>Voices</i>

YA PB M*	<u>Wildwood Dancing</u> By Juliet Marillier	7	Five sisters who live with their merchant father in Transylvania use a hidden portal in their home to cross over into a magical world, the Wildwood. Companion: <i>Cybele's Secret</i>
YA PB M*	<u>The Hunter's Moon</u> By O.R. Melling	7	Two teenage cousins, one Irish, the other from the United States, set out to find a magic doorway to the Faraway Country, where humans must bow to the little people.
YA PB M	<u>Un Lun Dun</u> By China Mieville	5	Twelve-year-old Zanna and her friend Deeba find a secret entrance leading out of London and into the strange city of Un Lun Dun, where all the lost and broken things of London end up. There, the girls learn that Zanna is the chosen one, a hero who can save Un Lun Dun from the Smog, an evil force that threatens to take over this magical city.
YA PB M*	<u>Bras and Broomsticks</u> By Sarah Mlynowski	6	Living in New York City with her mother and her younger sister, Miri, fourteen-year-old Rachel tries to persuade Miri, who has recently become a witch, to help her become popular at school and to try to stop their divorced father's wedding. Sequel: <i>Frogs and French Kisses</i>
YA MUR	<u>Princess Ben</u> By Catherine Gilbert Murdock	6	A girl is transformed, through instruction in life at court, determination, and magic, from sullen, pudgy, graceless Ben into Crown Princess Benevolence, a fit ruler of the kingdom of Montagne as it faces war with neighboring Drachensbett.
YA OWE *	<u>Here There Be Dragons</u> By James A. Owen	6	Three young men are entrusted with the Imaginarium Geographica, an atlas of fantastical places to which they travel in hopes of defeating the Winter King whose bid for power is related to the First World War raging in the Real World. Sequel: <i>The Search for the Red Dragon</i>
YA PB P *	<u>First Test</u> By Tamora Pierce	5	Keladry is the first girl to take advantage of the decree that permits girls to train for the knighthood. The only thing that can stop her is Lord Wyldon, the training master of pages and squires. He does not think girls should be knights and puts her on probation for one year. Sequel: <i>Page</i> .
YA REE *	<u>Larklight</u> By Philip Reeve	5	In an alternate Victorian England, young Arthur and his sister Myrtle, residents of Larklight, a floating house in one of Her Majesty's outer space territories, uncover a spidery plot to destroy the solar system. Sequel: <i>Starcross</i>
YA STR *	<u>Heroes of the Valley</u> By Jonathan Stroud	5	When young Halli Sveinsson plays a trick on Ragnor of the House of Hakonsson, he sets in motion a chain of events that will forever alter his destiny, forcing him to leave home and go on a hero's quest where he encounters highway robbers, terrifying monsters, and a girl who may finally be his match.
