YA COL	<u>The Hunger Games</u> By Suzanne Collins	6	Every year the Capitol city of Panem requires each of its districts to send two "tributes"--one boy and one girl--to participate in the nationally televised Hunger Games, where competitors fight to the death until only one tribute remains.
YA BER	<u>Exodus</u> By Julie Bertagna	6	In the year 2100, as the island of Wing is about to be covered by water, fifteen-year-old Mara discovers the existence of New World sky cities that are safe from the storms and rising waters, and convinces her people to travel to one of these cities in order to save themselves.
Teen DOC	<u>Little Brother</u> By Cory Doctorow	8	After being interrogated for days by the Department of Homeland Security in the aftermath of a major terrorist attack on San Francisco, California, seventeen-year-old Marcus, released into what is now a police state, decides to use his expertise in computer hacking to set things right.
YA ENT	<u>T.I.M. Defender of the Earth</u> By Sam Enthoven	5	TIM, aka Tyrannosaurus: Improved Model, is the product of a top-secret government military experiment, and he couldn't be more loveable. Sure, he's an enormous monster to most, but he could be all that stands between the earth and total destruction.
YA GAI	<u>Interworld</u> By Neil Gaiman	5	At 16, Joey Harker has just realized that he can literally walk into alternate realities. He quickly discovers that versions of himself from other worlds can also live on a secret base known as InterWorld. From here, an army of Joeys, of all different ages and characteristics, battle two evil groups bent on ruling all the earths in the Altiverse.
YA GRA	<u>Gone</u> By Michael Grant	5	In a small town on the coast of California, everyone over the age of fourteen suddenly disappears, setting up a battle between the remaining town residents and the students from a local private school, as well as those who have "The Power" and are able to perform supernatural feats and those who do not.

YA KAW	<u>.hack//another birth. Vol. 1, Infection</u> By Miu Kawasaki	6	In order for Akira to save her younger brother, who has suddenly lost consciousness in an online fantasy game, she enters the game herself.
YA KOS	<u>Epic</u> By Conor Kostick	5	On New Earth, a world based on a video role-playing game, fourteen-year-old Erik persuades his friends to aid him in some unusual gambits in order to save Erik's father from exile and safeguard the futures of each of their families. Sequel: <i>Saga</i>
YA PB M	<u>The Declaration</u> By Gemma Malley	5	In 2140 London, everyone takes Longevity, a drug that allows people to live forever. Of course, with everyone living forever, that means no one's allowed to have children anymore unless they Opt Out of taking the drugs at age sixteen. Fourteen year old Anna is a Surplus - a child that was born illegally to parents who were taking Longevity. Sequel: <i>The Resistance</i>
Teen PEA	<u>The Adoration of Jenna Fox</u> By Mary Pearson	7	Who is Jenna Fox? Seventeen-year-old Jenna has just awoken from a coma, they tell her, and she is still recovering from a terrible accident in which she was involved a year ago. But what happened before that? Jenna doesn't remember her life. Or does she? And are the memories really hers?
YA PFE	<u>Life As We Knew It</u> By Susan Beth Pfeffer	6	After an asteroid hits the moon, catastrophic climate changes affect the planet. Sixteen year old Miranda keeps a diary of her family's struggle to survive in the year after the disaster. Companion: <i>the dead & the gone</i>
YA SHU	<u>Unwind</u> By Neal Shusterman	6	In the near future, three unwanted teenagers face a fate worse than death -- unwinding. Their bodies will be cut up, and every part of them used, from their brains to their toes. But if they can stay out of the authorities' clutches until the age of eighteen, they just might survive.
YA PB W	<u>Storm Thief</u> By Chris Wooding	7	When teenage thieves Rail and Moa decide to keep a technological artifact they've been sent to steal, the pair find themselves hunted by not only their thief-mistress, but also by the secret police--for the item they've nicked may unlock the dark secrets of their chaotic and miserable world.
