YA BRE	<u>Chronicles of Vladimir Tod: Eighth Grade Bites</u> By Heather Brewer	6 – 9	Junior high really sucks for thirteen-year-old Vladimir Tod. Bullies harass him, the principal is dogging him, and the girl he likes prefers his best friend. Oh, and Vlad has a secret: his mother was human, but his father was a vampire.
Teen DEL	<u>Blue Bloods</u> By Melissa DeLaCruz	7 – 12	Select teenagers from some of New York City's wealthiest and most socially prominent families learn a startling secret about their bloodlines – they're really vampires.
YA HAR	<u>The Secret Life of Sparrow Delaney</u> By Suzanne Harper	6 – 10	Fifteen year old Sparrow Delaney has been seeing ghosts since she was five. But she's always hidden her abilities from her psychically talented family. But when she starts seeing the ghost of a teenage boy who will not leave her alone, will she 'come out' in order to help him?
Teen JOH	<u>Devilish</u> By Maureen Johnson	7 – 12	Jane Jarvis, a senior at a Catholic girl's school in Providence, Rhode Island, tries to save her best friend by making a pact with a demon--in the form of a cupcake-eating, very friendly teenage girl.
YA LEA	<u>Keturah and Lord Death</u> By Martine Leavitt	7 – 10	When Lord Death comes to claim sixteen-year-old Keturah while she is lost in the King's Forest, she charms him with her story and is granted a twenty-four hour reprieve in which to seek her one true love.
Teen MEY	<u>Twilight</u> By Stephenie Meyer	6 & up	When seventeen-year-old Bella leaves Phoenix to live with her father in Forks, Washington, she meets an exquisitely handsome boy at school for whom she feels an overwhelming attraction and who she comes to realize is not wholly human.
YA MLY	<u>Bras and Broomsticks</u> By Sarah Mlynowski	6 – 9	Living in New York City with her mother and her younger sister, Miri, fourteen-year-old Rachel tries to persuade Miri, who has recently become a witch, to help her become popular at school and to try to stop their divorced father's wedding.
YA SHU	<u>Everlost</u> By Neal Shusterman	6 – 9	When Nick and Allie are killed in a car crash, they end up in Everlost, or limbo for lost souls, where although Nick is satisfied, Allie will stop at nothing--even skinjacking--to break free.
YA SHA	<u>Lord Loss: Demonata #1</u> By Darren Shan	7 – 10	Presumably the only witness to the horrific and bloody murder of his entire family, a teenage boy must outwit not only the mental health professionals determined to cure his delusion, but also the demonic forces only he can see.
YA PB SLE	<u>The Boy Who Couldn't Die</u> By William Sleator	7 - 10	When his best friend dies in a plane crash, sixteen-year-old Ken has a ritual performed that will make him invulnerable, but soon learns that he had good reason to be suspicious of the woman he paid to lock his soul away.
Teen ZEV	<u>Elsewhere</u> By Gabrielle Zevin	7 – 10	After fifteen-year-old Liz Hall is hit by a taxi and killed, she finds herself in a place that is both like and unlike Earth, where she must adjust to her new status and figure out how to "live."
