Teen COH	<u>Nick and Norah's Infinite Playlist</u> By Rachel Cohn & David Levithan	9 – 12	What happens when two witty, wise, but vulnerable teens meet by accident at a chaotic NYC punk rock club? They fall in love, of course. It all begins when queercore bassist Nick convinces a stranger to pose as his girlfriend in order to fool Tris, the girl who broke his heart.
Teen COO	<u>So Lyrical</u> By Trish Cook	7 - 12	The life of Winnetka, Illinois, high schooler Trace revolves around her young, music-loving mother, an unknown father, a voluptuous best friend who may be going off the deep end, and the rich, gorgeous lead singer in a band.
YA DES	<u>This Lullaby</u> By Sarah Dessen	7 - 12	Raised by a mother who's had five husbands, eighteen-year-old Remy believes in short-term, no-commitment relationships until she meets Dexter, a rock band musician.
Teen GOI	<u>Fat Kid Rules the World</u> By K.L. Going	8 - 12	Seventeen-year-old Troy, depressed, suicidal, and weighing nearly 300 pounds, gets a new perspective on life when a homeless teenager who is a genius on guitar wants Troy to be the drummer in his rock band.
YA HUG	<u>Lemonade Mouth</u> By Mark Peter Hughes	6 - 9	A disparate group of high school students thrown together in detention form a band to play at a school talent show and end up competing with a wildly popular local rock band.
YA KOR	<u>Born to Rock</u> By Gordon Korman	7 - 10	17 year old Leo is a member of the Young Republicans, accepted to Harvard early decision when he learns that his biological father is Marion X. McMurphy aka "King Maggot" - the lead singer of the greatest punk band in the 80s.
Teen NEL	<u>Rock Star Superstar</u> By Blake Nelson	8 – 12	High school bassist and music legacy Pete (dad was a rocker, his mom, who died when Pete was 7, a folkie) reluctantly joins the band Tiny Masters of Today and experiences the highs and lows of becoming a locally famous musician.
YA POW	<u>Tribute to Another Dead Rock Star</u> By Randy Powell	6 – 9	For a tribute to his mother, a dead rock star, fifteen-year-old Grady returns to Seattle, where he faces his mixed feelings for his retarded younger half-brother Louie while pondering his own future.
Teen WAT	<u>The Beautiful City of the Dead</u> By Leander Watts	8 - 12	After joining a heavy metal band, high school student Zee learns that she is a god of water and is called upon to fight sinister forces that want her powers for their own.
Teen WES	<u>The Last Days</u> By Scott Westerfeld	8 - 12	As an ancient evil stirs beneath the streets of New York City, infecting rats and people like a plague, five quirky teens come together to form a "New Sound" band whose music seems to have paranormal power. Sequel to "Peeps"
